ON THIS DATE WHILE ASSIGNED TO HOMICIDE CAR 8153, IN COMPANY WITH DETECTIVE MOORE#836, WE RECEIVED AN ASSIGNMENT FROM DETECTIVE STEVERS OF THE HOMICIDE OFFICE OF A DEAD BODY IN THE WOODLAND CEMETERY LOCATED AT EAST 69 & QUINCY. SHE FURTHER ADVISED US THAT THIS ASSIGNMENT WAS RECEIVED FROM CHANNEL 5 DISPATCHER MAINOR #14, AT 1008 HOURS.

RESPONDED FROM EAST 72ND & KINSMAN AND ARRIVED ON SCENE AT 1020 HOURS, AND MET WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS OF THE DEPARTMENT, AND TOGETHER CONDUCTED THE FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION. CAR 553 LT. BUNGO, CAR 544 SGT. GEORGE, ZONE CAR 522 OFFICER ROBINSON#2259 & OFFICER LEWIS#89, S.I.U. CAR 8111 LT. KAPANTAS, AND 8117 DETECTIVE WILSON, ALONG WITH EMS UNIT #9, EMT CIARRONE#160 AND EMT BUESCHER#215.

VICTIM;

UNIDENTIFIED WHITE MALE, APPROXIMATELY 25 TO 35 YEARS OF AGE, THIS MALE WAS FOUND TO BE 78 INCHES TALL, AND WEIGH 210 POUNDS. HE HAD MEDIUM LENGTH MIXED BROWN AND GRAY HAIR, AND MUSTACHE, AND A TATTOO OF A KNIGHT ON A HORSE ABOVE NIPPLE ON LEFT SIDE OF CHEST..... THIS MALE HAD A MASSIVE AMOUNT OF DRIED BLOOD WHICH COVERED HIS FACE AND HEAD, WITH APPARENT DEFECTS TO LEFT SIDE OF THROAT, LEFT SHOULDER, AND UPPER LIP.

THE ABOVE MALE WAS FOUND LYING IN DRIVEWAY OF CEMETERY, SOUTH OF THE QUINCY AVENUE ENTRANCE, ON HIS STOMACH. HIS HEAD TO THE SOUTH, AND THE RIGHT SIDE OF HIS FACE TOUCHING THE GROUND. HIS FEET WERE TOGETHER AND POINTING TO THE NORTH. HIS RIGHT ARM WAS EXTENDED UPWARD IN SOUTHERNLY DIRECTION ABOVE HIS HEAD, BENT AT THE ELBOW, AND HIS FINGERS POINTED TO THE EAST. HIS LEFT ARM WAS TOUCHING THE LEFT SIDE OF HIS BODY, BENT AT THE ELBOW, AND UNDERNEATH THE BODY WITH HIS FINGERS TOUCHING HIS CHEST.... NOTE; (THIS ENTIRE AREA WAS SNOW COVERED AND APP- EARED TO BE FRESHLY PLOWED).

THIS MALE WAS FOUND WITH NO SHIRT OR OTHER UPPER GARMENTS. HE WAS ONLY WEARING LIGHT BLUE GITANO JEANS. ONE PAIR OF HI-TOP BLACK WITH WHITE STRIPE AIR FLIGHT TENNIS SHOES. ONE PAIR OF WHITE SOCKS, AND WHITE JOCKEY UNDER PANTS. THIS MALE HAD NO WATCH, RINGS OR OTHER TYPE OF JEWELRY WHEN HIS BODY WAS DISCOVERED.

THIS MALE WAS CONVEYED FROM SCENE BY CUYAHOGA AMBULANCE UNIT #71 ATTENDANTS ACORD & HARRIS, TO THE MORGUE WHERE HE WAS PRONOUNCED BY DR. CHALLENGER AT 1208 HOURS.

THIS MALES BODY WAS RECEIVED BY ATTENDANTS BARAN AND DUNCAN. THIS MALE WAS FOUND TO BE 78 INCHES TALL AND 210 POUNDS. THIS BODY WAS PARTIALLY FROZEN AND COVERED WITH DRIED BLOOD. HIS CLOTHING CONSISTED OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS;

CRIME SCENE;

THE ENTRANCE TO WOODLAND CEMETERY IS LOCATED ON THE S/S OF QUINCY AVENUE. THE ENTRANCE DRIVEWAY WHICH IS 10' WIDE TRAVELS SOUTH 338' TO 2ND DRIVEWAY WHICH IS ALSO 10' WIDE AND RUNS EAST AND WEST. THE VICTIMS BODY WAS FOUND 101' EAST OF THE ENTRANCE DRIVEWAY IN THE 2ND DRIVEWAY. THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WERE FOUND WEST OF THE VICTIMS BODY;

AS WE APPROACHED THE BODY FROM THE ENTRANCE DRIVEWAY WE FOUND A RED BIC CIGARETTE LIGHTER 40" SOUTH OF VICTIMS RIGHT ELBOW, AND 94" SOUTH OF HIS RIGHT FOOT. WE ALSO FOUND A QUARTER (25¢), 91" SOUTH OF HIS RIGHT FOOT, AND 38" WEST OF HIS RIGHT ELBOW. THESE ITEMS WERE 6" APART. WE OBSERVED A LARGE BLOOD STAIN 21'9" WEST OF VICTIMS RIGHT FOOT. THIS BLOOD SPOT HAD NUMEROUS HAIRS IN SAME.

WE FOUND (1) LIVE .32 CALIBER SHELL 22' WEST OF VICTIMS RIGHT FOOT. WE ALSO FOUND A METAL SPRING (POSSIBLY FROM A AUTOMATIC WEAPON) 20'8" WEST OF HIS RIGHT FOOT. WE LOCATED A METAL GUN PART (POSSIBLY A FIRING MECHANISM) 21'11" WEST OF VICTIMS RIGHT FOOT.

LARGE BLOOD SPOT WITH HAIR IN SAME WAS FOUND TO BE 80' EAST OF ENTRANCE DRIVEWAY. THERE WERE SEPARATE HAIR LOCATED 83' EAST OF ENTRANCE DRIVEWAY, ON S/S OF DRIVEWAY WHERE VICTIMS BODY WAS FOUND. WE ALSO LOCATED (1) SPENT .32 CALIBER SHELL CASING UNDER VICTIMS LEFT LEG WHEN HE WAS MOVED BY THE CORONER'S OFFICE PERSONEL...

(TOMBSTONE WITH THE NAME PAUL ZARO DIRECTLY ADJACENT TO VICTIMS BODY ON THE NORTH SIDE OF DRIVEWAY)....

THIS MALE VICTIMS BODY WAS FOUND TO BE 80' WEST OF ANOTHER DRIVEWAY WHICH RUNS NORTH AND SOUTH AND LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF VICTIM. WE FOUND A PACK OF WINSTON CIGARETTES 21'5" EAST OF VICTIMS RIGHT HAND AND 20" SOUTH OF NORTH CURB OF DRIVE. CIGARETTE PACK WAS FOUND TO BE 22'4" EAST OF HIS LEFT FOOT. WE FOUND A GREEN LIGHTER 12' SOUTH OF THE CIGARETTE PACK. WE FOUND A LARGE BLOOD STAIN 13' EAST OF THE CIGARETTE PACK. WE ALSO LOCATED A BLUE WOOL JACKET 15' SOUTH OF THE CIGARETTE PACK, AND A PURPLE AND BLACK PRINT SHIRT 14' SOUTH OF THIS CIGARETTE PACK. BOTH THE SHIRT AND THE JACKET WERE 17" APART. ALSO LOCATED EAST OF THE BODY WERE 15' OF SWIRLED TIRE TRACKS THAT APPEARED TO BE TRAVELING EAST AWAY FROM THE BODY..... SEE DIAGRAM ATTACHED TO THIS FILE.

THE SCENE WAS COMPLETELY SNOW COVERED AND THE DRIVEWAYS WERE FRESHLY PLOWED. THE TEMPERATURE OUTSIDE AT THE TIME THIS MALES BODY WAS LOCATED WAS FOUND TO BE -16 DEGREES. THE WINDS WERE SOUTHWEST AT 14 MPH.....

INVESTIGATION;

UPON OUR ARRIVAL AT THE SCENE WE MET WITH MEMBERS OF ZONE CAR 522 WHO REPORTED RECEIVING A RADIO BROADCAST TO RESPOND TO EAST 69TH & QUINCY C/W A DOA AND ARRIVING ON SCENE AT 1005 HOURS. AFTER MEETING WITH EMS PERSONEL THEY THEN NOTIFIED RADIO TO CONTACT THE HOMICIDE UNIT IN C/W THEIR ASSIGNMENT. CONDUCTING A SYSTEMATIC INVESTIGATION OF THE CRIME SCENE AS OUTLINE IN CRIME SCENE WE CAUSED ALL OF THE AFOREMENTIONED ITEMS TO BE PHOTOGRAPHED IN PLACE AND TAKEN INTO EVIDENCE.

WE FOUND THIS AREA TO BE A CEMETERY WHICH CONSISTED OF APPROXIMATELY 5000 GRAVE SITES AND HEAD STONES. THIS AREA IS SITUATED IN A ISOLATED LOCATED AREA WITH A LIMITED NUMBER OF HOMES AND COMERCIAL BUSINESSES AROUND SAME.

INTERVIEWED CNSTER BROWN WHO REPORTED REPORTING TO WORK AT SHEET METAL SALES LOCATED DIRECTLY ACROSS THE STREET FROM CEMETERY AT 0800 HOURS THIS DATE. HE STATED HE HEARD NO GUN SHOTS NOR SEEN ANY UNUSAL ACTIVITY. HE FURTHER REPORTED SEEING A WHITE CITY OF CLEVELAND MAINTENANCE TRUCK IN THE CEMETERY BETWEEN 0830 AND 0845 HOURS. HE STATES HE NOTICED THE TRUCK BOTH YESTERDAY AND TO DAY AT THE SAME TIME.. NOTHING FURTHER.

AT THIS TIME WE RESPONDED TO THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY CORONER'S OFFICE WHERE WE MET WITH DR. CHALLENGER, AND TRACE EVIDENCE TECHNICIAN ROSENBERG WHO REPORTED THIS MALE VICTIMS BODY PARTIALLY FROZEN AND POST TO BE CONDUCTED IN THE AM 01-20-94. WHILE AT THE CORONER'S OFFICE WE ALSO OBSERVED DEFECTS TO THE VICTIMS LEFT SIDE OF THROAT, LEFT SHOULDER, AND UPPER LIP.

CONFERRED WITH STEPHANIE RADCLIFF WHO IS ACTING COMMISIONER OF THE PARKS, MAINTENANCE, AND PROPERTIES FOR THE CITY OF CLEVELAND AND FOUND THE CORRECT ADDRESS OF THE WOODLAND CEMETERY TO BE 6901 WOODLAND. SHE FURTHER REPORTED THE ENTRANCE GATE TO CEMETERY AT EAST 69TH & QUINCY NEVER LOCKED TO ALLOW POLICE CARS TO PATROL CEMETERY DUE TO VANDALISMS. SHE STATES A CREW OF 4 MEN AT THE CEMETERY THIS DATE AND THE FOREMAN TO BE LEWIS POHORENCE, WHO CAN BE REACHED AT 348-7210. SHE REPORTS WORK CREW TO BE IN THE CEMETERY SOMETIME AFTER 0730 HOURS THIS DATE, BUT UNSURE OF EXACT TIME UNTIL FORMAL REPORT IS MADE BY THE FOREMAN. THESE REPORTONG DETECTIVES UNABLE TO REACH MR. POHORENCE DUE TO CREW REPORTING OFF DUTY AT 1500 HOURS.

CONFERRED WITH DISPATCHER BENDER AND REQUESTED A COPY OF ALL RADIO TAPES AND 911 CALLS TO BE DUPLICATED AND FORWARDED TO THIS OFFICE.

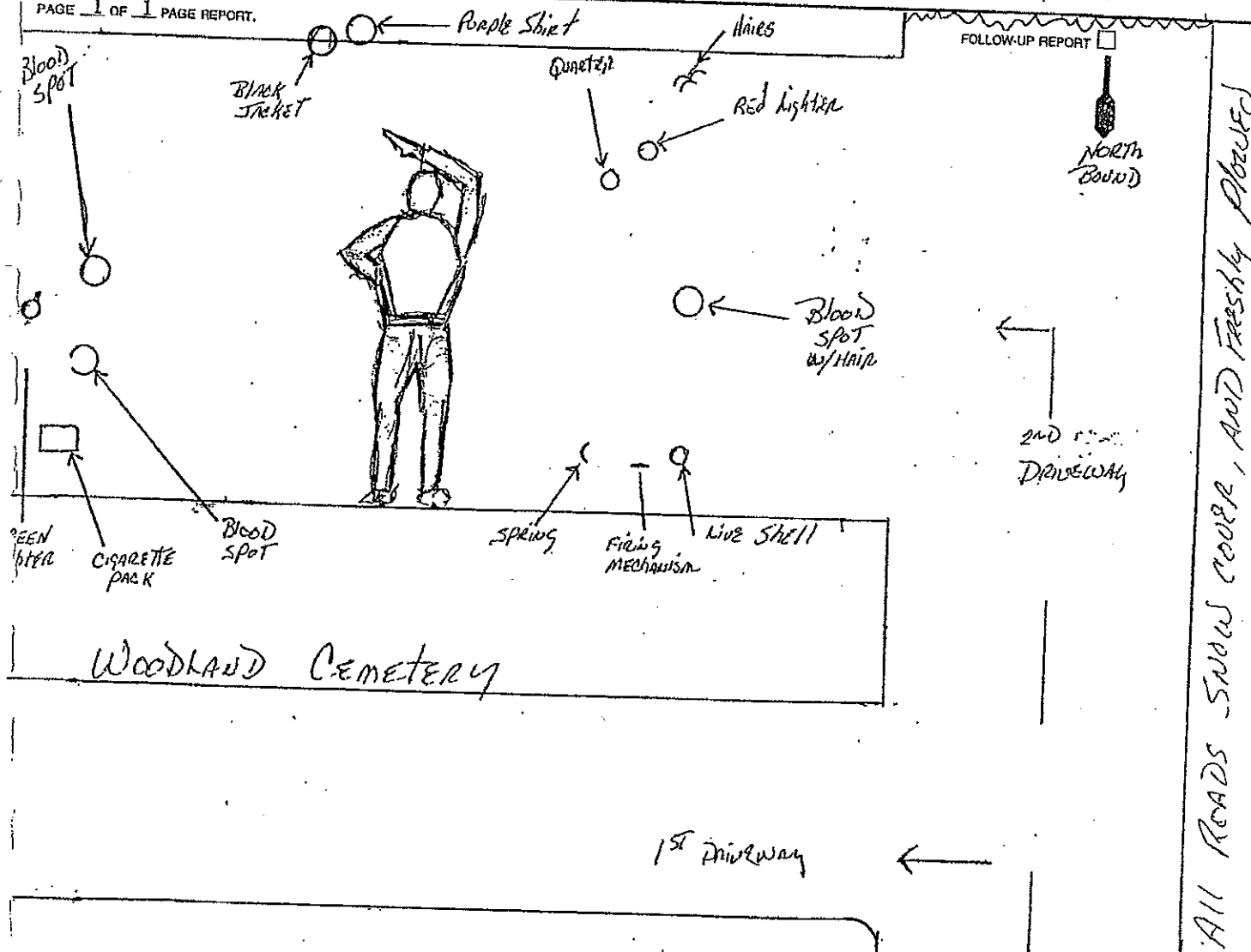
