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FOLLOW-UP REPORT ☐

On this date Thursday March 31, 1994 while assigned to Homicide Car#8153 in company with Det. Reese#1712 received an office assignment from Sergt. Skorich to further investigate the above Homicide.

At the City Prosecutor's Office conferred with Assistant Prosecutor Ed Buelow who stated that he was conferring with a female-Carrie Jean Bandy concerning Assault Charges against Andre Eugene Smith. Pros. Buelow further stated that he was informed by Carrie Bandy that Andre Smith could be a Suspect in a Murder that occurred in the Cemetery located on Woodland Ave.

At the Homicide Office conferred with Carrie Jean Bandy B-F-32 DOB [REDACTED] and resides at 15018 Upton Ave., 481-6982 who stated that she met Andre Eugene Smith DOB [REDACTED] in Feb-93. Carrie Bandy further stated that Andre Smith was released from Lucasville Prison on Jan-29, 1993 and in February-1993 while at her mother's house (Mary Thomas-7800 Myron Ave-431-5005) she became acquainted with Andre Smith because his brother William Townsend who also uses the last name of Ellison rented a room from her mother. Carrie Bandy also stated that she had just been separated from her children's father Bert Brown B-M-32 DOB [REDACTED] Myron Ave. and they were involved in an altercation concerning Andre Smith. Carrie Bandy then stated that Andre Smith shot Bert Brown with a .22 Caliber Automatic in the hip area and Bert Brown never filed Charges against Andre Smith concerning the shooting.

Carrie Bandy also stated that in Jan-94 she overheard a conversation that Andre Smith was having on her telephone and Andre stated "Man Did You Hear About The Body That Was Found In The Cemetery, Man I Had To Do Him Because I Thought He Had Some Cheese, And The Guy Would Not Cooperate And I Had To Do Him". Carrie Bandy then stated that she heard Andre Smith asked "What's Up, Yall Got Any Licks Tonight", and Andre Smith changed the conversation because Carrie Bandy stated that she walked into the room.

Carrie Bandy was then asked if she could remember any of Andre Friends and she stated that one of his friend's name is Wayne Tipton who lives in the area of East 79th and Cedar Ave. and Demetrius Last Name Unknown aka "Hollywood". Carrie Bandy also stated that Andre Smith would go to Mentor, Ohio and buy several type of weapons and then sell the weapons out on the Street for more money than the purchased price.

Carrie Bandy also stated that she did not know if Andre Smith had any relatives in Elyria, Ohio.
