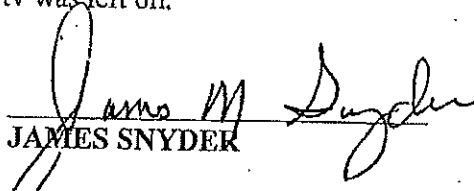

DECLARATION OF JAMES SNYDER

STATE OF OHIO,
COUNTY OF LORAIN:

- 1) My name is James Snyder. I am a resident of Lorain County, Ohio.
- 2) In 1994 I was the landlord, or manager, of the apartment building where Ron Lally was living in January of that year. The apartment building was located at 516 Middle Avenue in Elyria, Ohio. The building was essentially a rooming house.
- 3) The rooms were rented out to single individuals – multiple occupancy was not permitted. Overnight guests were not allowed. So Ron Lally would not have had, and did not have, a roommate living with him in January of 1994. I lived in the same building so I would know if any of the tenants had a roommate.
- 4) I recall when Ron Lally came up missing from his apartment in January of 1994. It was unusual in that he left all of his belongings in the apartment. It was also unusual in that his door had been left unlocked and his tv was left on.

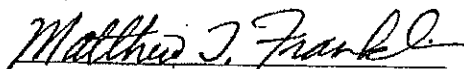
